residential camping program at **Camp Shawnee** • **Camp WIN (Women's Intersport Network)** is a self-esteem and confidence building program for girls. • **Wonderland Camp** in the Ozarks is a week-long residential camp for campers with physical and mental challenges. • **Camp Wood YMCA**, offers traditional camp experiences for kids 7-17, located near Emporia, KS, in the heart of the Flint Hills. • **Community School of Arts Camp** offers exciting and enriching arts experiences for kids 5-15. **Girl Scouts** provide camperships to **four camps** for girls with financial disadvantages, one specifically for girls with developmental disabilities and other challenges. • **Heartland Presbyterian Center** operates a summer-long residential camping program, **Heartland Camp**. • **Horizon Academy** offers a summer program for students with learning disabilities • **Joshua Center Camp** provides a 5-day/4 night camp for kids with Tourette, Aspergers and OCD. • **Camp Encourage** offers a four-day resident camp for children with autism. • **Mattie Rhodes Center** emphasizes art in its summer learning program. • **Operation Breakthrough** sponsors a summer learning program for inner-city kids. • **Royal Family Kids Camp** serves kids in foster care. • **Camp Shakespeare** offers a theatre experience that teaches the value of teamwork. • **Whatever Community Center** offers life skills and recreation programs throughout the summer. • **Wildwood Summer Learning Program** operates a resident camp and summer learning programs near LaCygne, KS. • **Youth Volunteer Corps Summer Sensation** offers opportunities for middle and high school students (11-18) to do community service. • **Kansas City Young Audiences** offers students an opportunity to explore their own artistic and creative abilities. • **Kansas City Urban Youth Center** offers an 8-week summer program located in low-income housing developments.
