



Who is in the ETT Program?

O Young adults (high school seniors through age 25) with Tourette Syndrome, Obsessive Compulsive Disorder and High Functioning Autism.

When does ETT meet?

- Currently the classes meet the 2nd & 4th Saturdays for 1 ½ hours.
- O Each class is \$40.
- Additional social experiences are being planned.
- Job Shadowing Experiences are scheduled according to career interest inventories.

What skills are taught in ETT?


