<u>Action verbs</u>: Advocated, fielded, consulted, arbitrated, mediated, informed, resolved, interfaced, updated, unified, motivated, explained, guided, facilitated, clarified, enabled

Scenario: You're a corporate time/money saver.

- Tired verbs: saved, improved
- <u>Action verbs</u>: Capitalized, enhanced, expedited, stimulated, maximized, solved, strengthened, settled, reconciled, eased, elevated, negotiated, standardized, influenced, arbitrated, boosted
